



## Hourly rates by age



### Remarkable

Freelancers **between 50 and 59 years old**charge the highest hourly rate at

\$117

followed by those **between 60 and 69 years old** who receive \$111/hr.

The youngest freelancers (under 30 years old) receive the lowest rates with \$73/hr on average.

## Hourly rates by role



Remarkable \$117 is the average hourly rate of consultants. Managers and project leads receive \$115/hour on average.




Freelancers working in the **aerospace** industry earn an average hourly rate of































What is the relationship between female and male freelancers?









What is your area of expertise?





What was your position in the last (or current) project?





In which field was your last (or current) project?


























