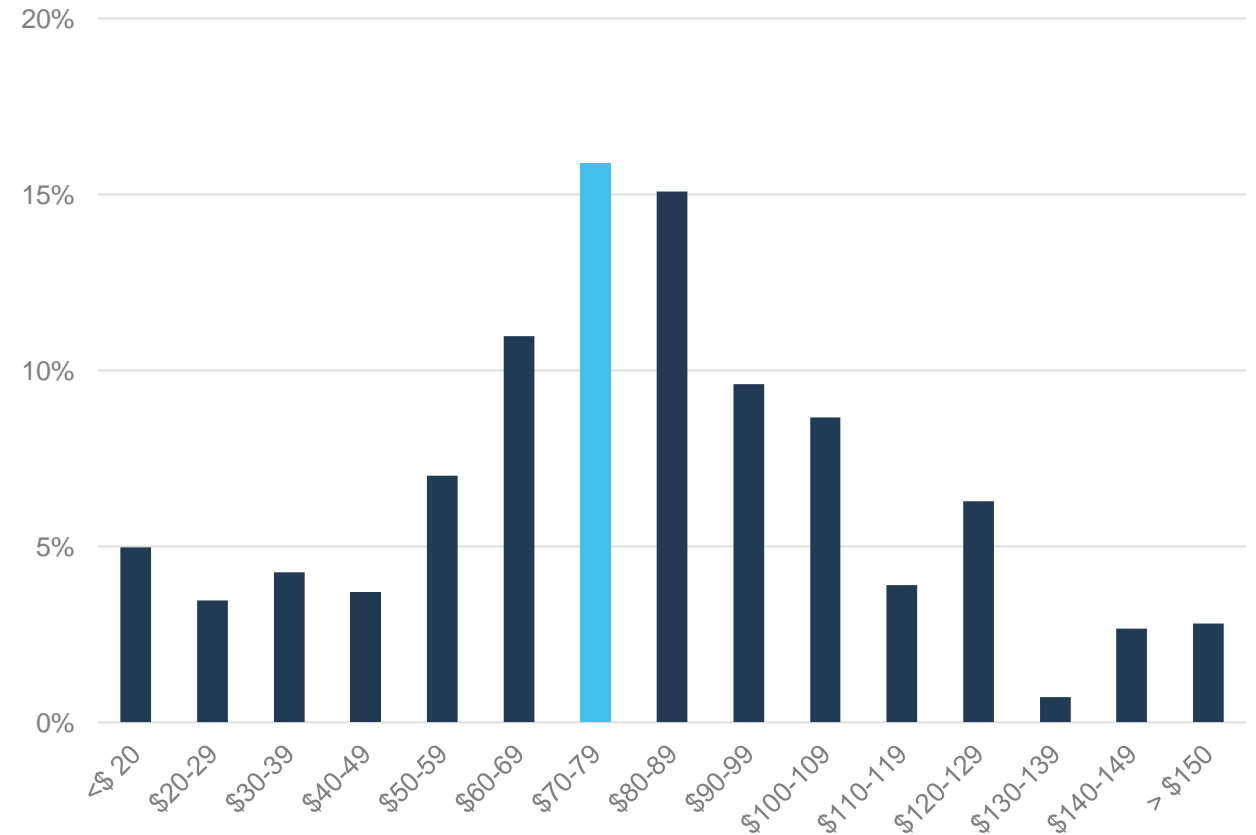
What is your all-inclusive hourly rate (USD)?

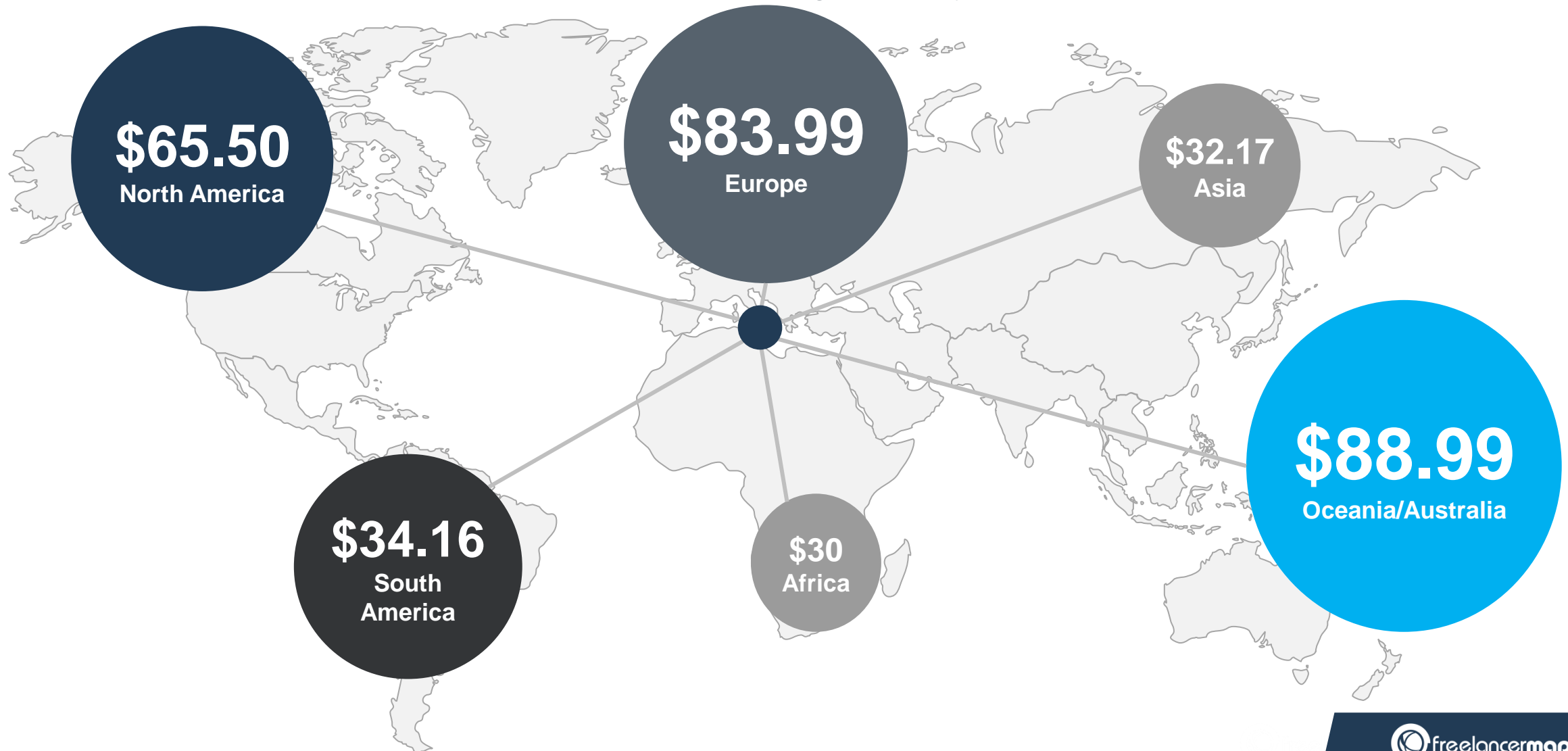
The majority of freelancers (**51.55%**) charge **between \$60 and \$99** an hour for their job.

23.39% charge **less than \$60** and **25.05%** command **over \$100** per hour.



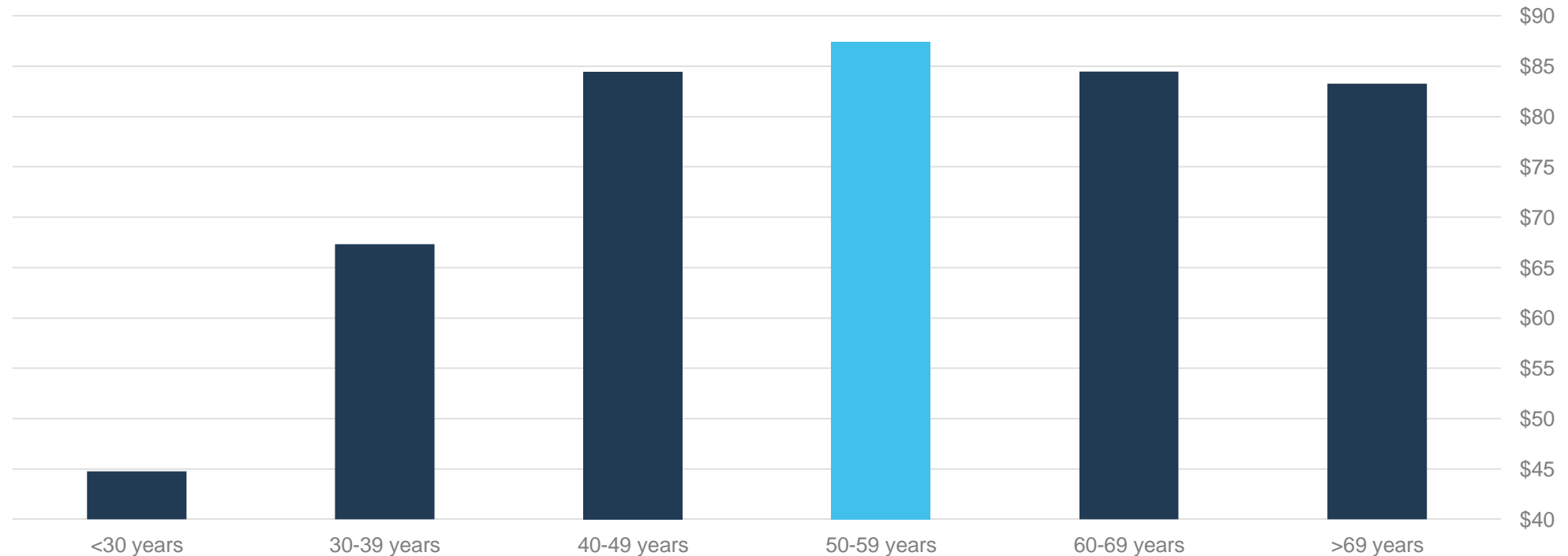
HOURLY RATES BY CONTINENT

Hourly rates according to age



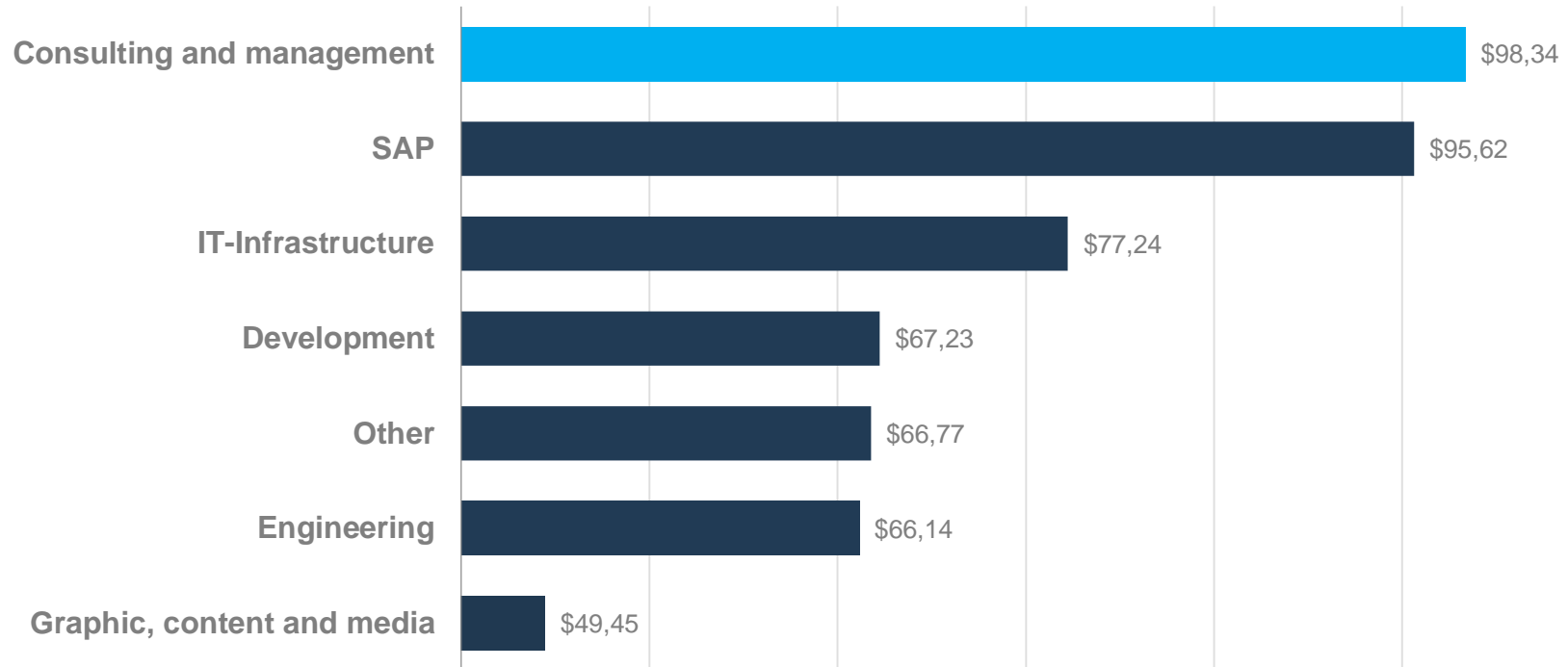
Freelancers **between 50 and 59** years old receive the highest hourly rates with **\$87.45**.

Younger freelancers (**under 30 years**) receive the lowest hourly rate of **\$44.76** on average.

Professionals **over 60 years old** earn slightly less than the previous generation with **\$83.88**.

AVERAGE RATES BY INDUSTRY

Average hourly rates for freelancers in different industries

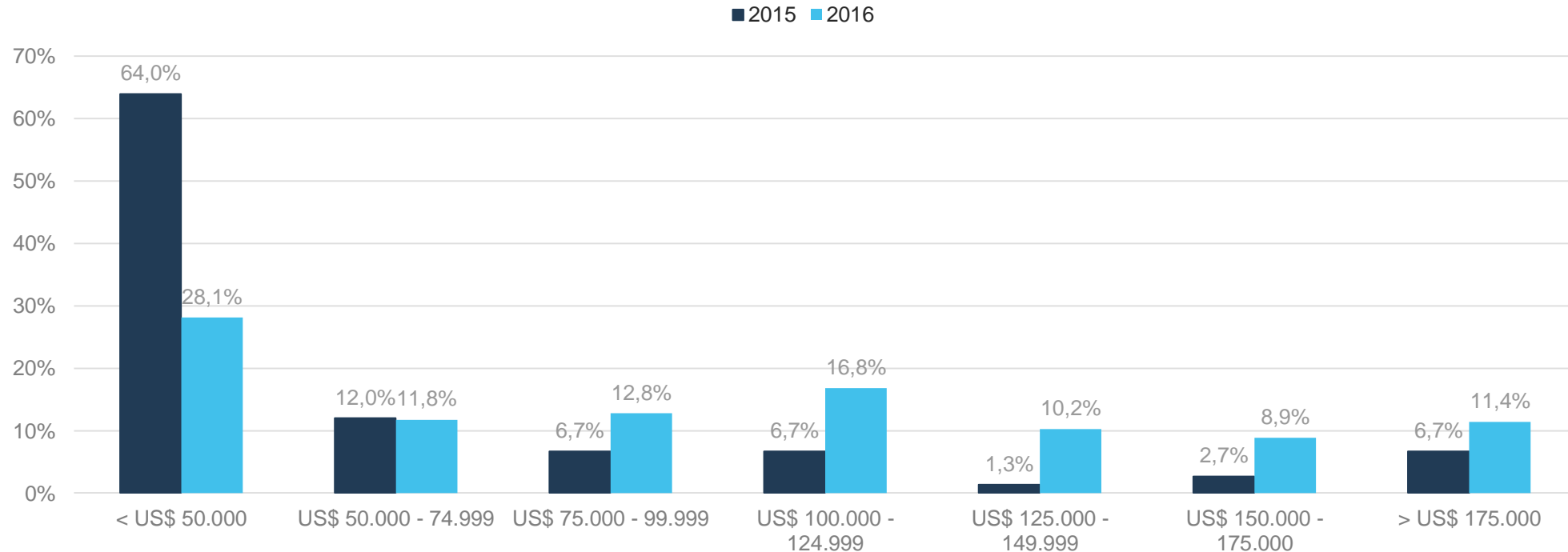


\$98.34 per hour is the average hourly rate among **IT consultants and managers**.

SAP consultants are charging **\$95.62** per hour for their services. The lowest rates, with an average of **\$49.45** per hour, are earned by professionals working in the **graphics, content, and media** field.

What was your gross turnover in 2016 (USD)?

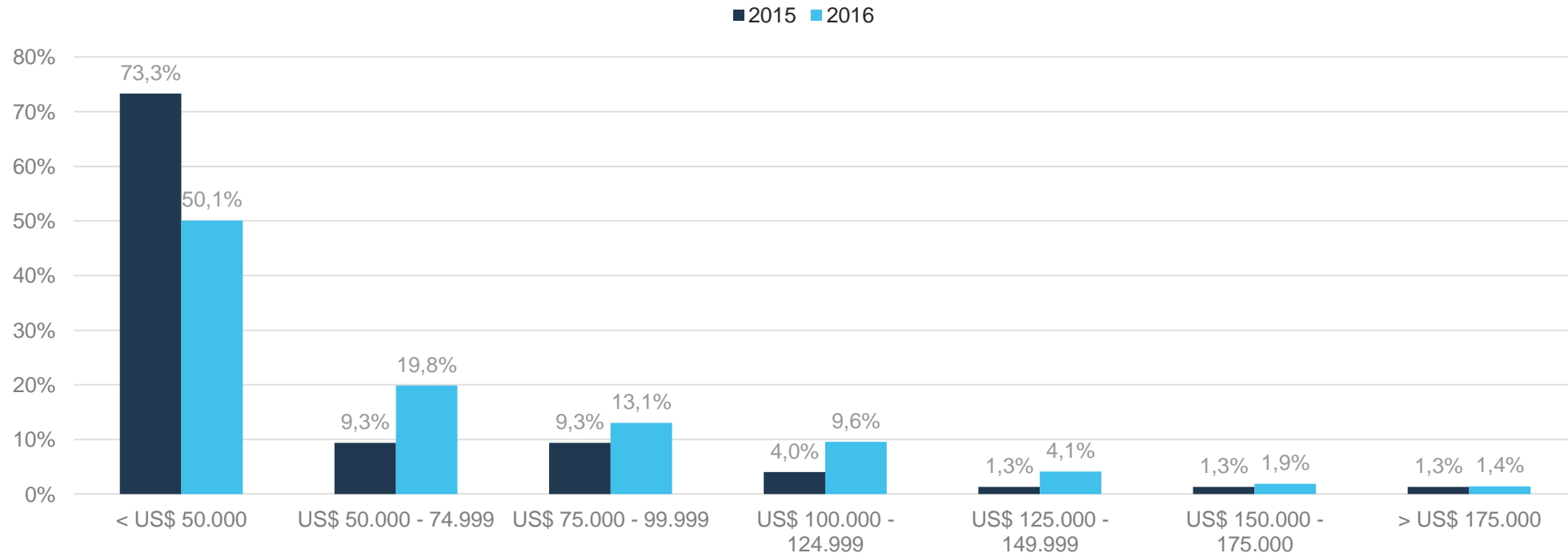


GROSS TURNOVER RAMP UP

On last year survey, the majority of freelancers (64%) confirmed that their turnover in 2015 was under \$ 50,000. **In 2016**, the number of freelancers earning **less than \$50,000 dropped by almost a 30%**. It's interesting to see that **47.33%** of the surveyed freelancers stepped over the magical **\$100,000**.

What was your gross profit in 2016 (USD)?

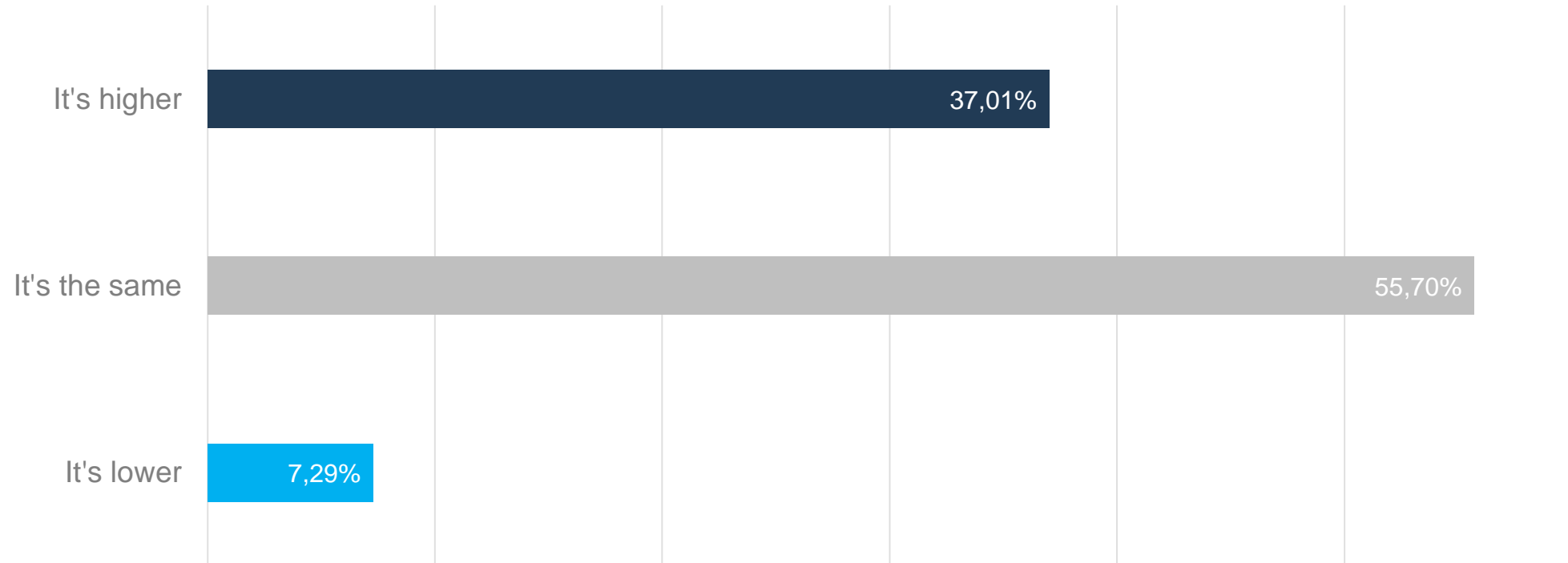


GROSS PROFITS INCREASE, TOO

In 2016 the percentage of freelancers that earn **less than \$50,000** dropped to a **50.1%** between all surveyed. **39.90%** confirmed they earned between **50,000 and \$99,999**; **9.6 %** affirmed they got **up to \$124,999**. The remaining **7.4%** earned over **\$125,000**.

HOURLY RATE DEVELOPMENT

Has your hourly rate increased comparing with 2016?

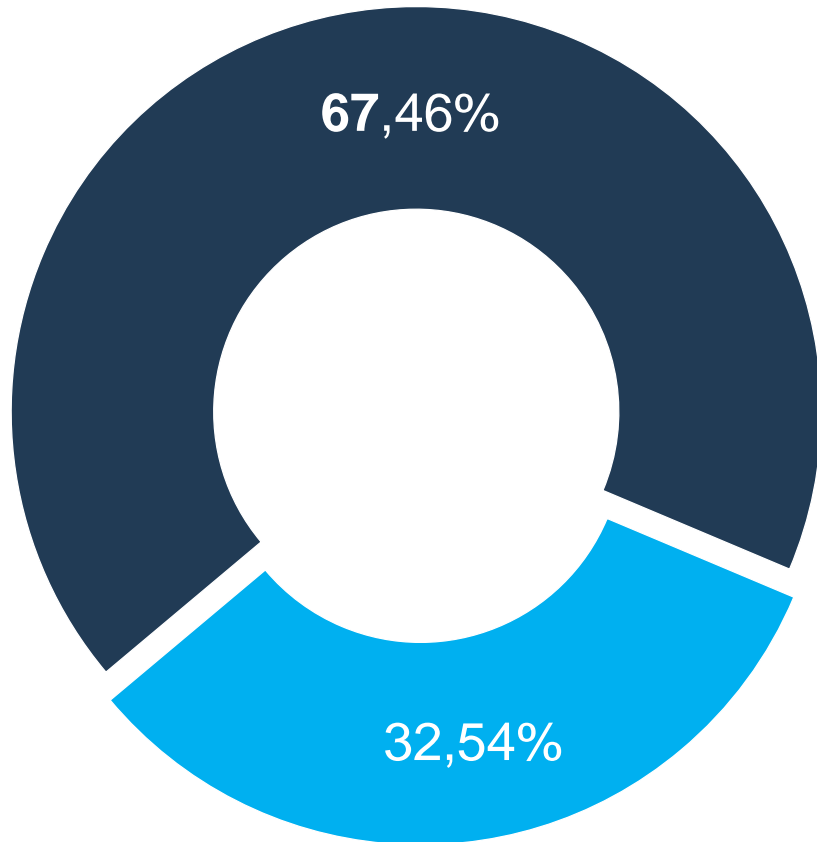


37.01% increased their hourly rates compared to 2016.

The majority of freelancers (55.70%) didn't change their rates, while 7.29% had to lower them.

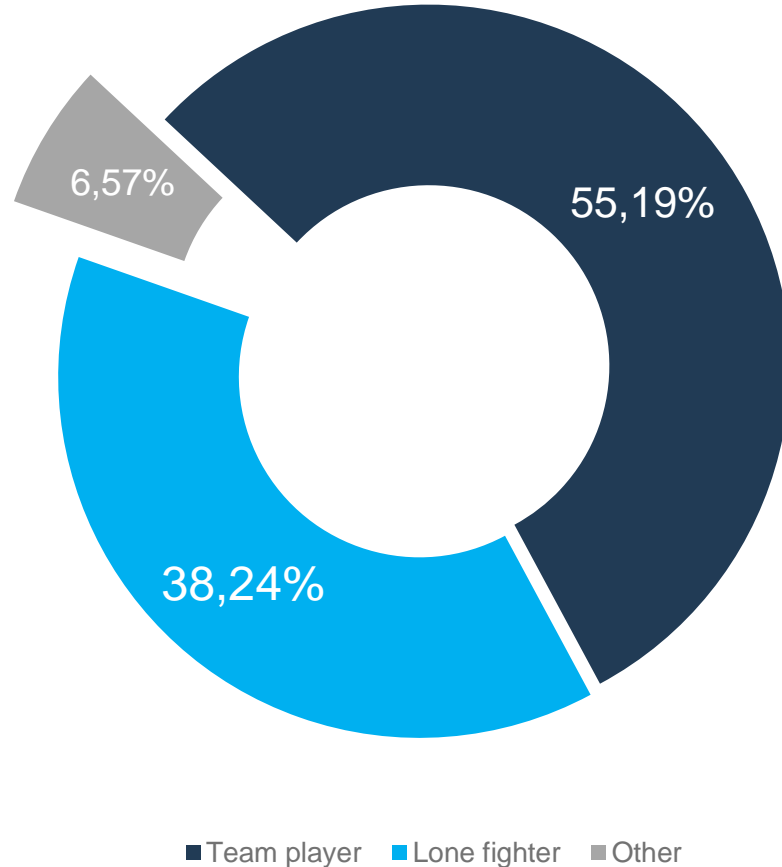
32.54 % of the freelancers surveyed were **unhappy** with their income.

LONE FIGHTER

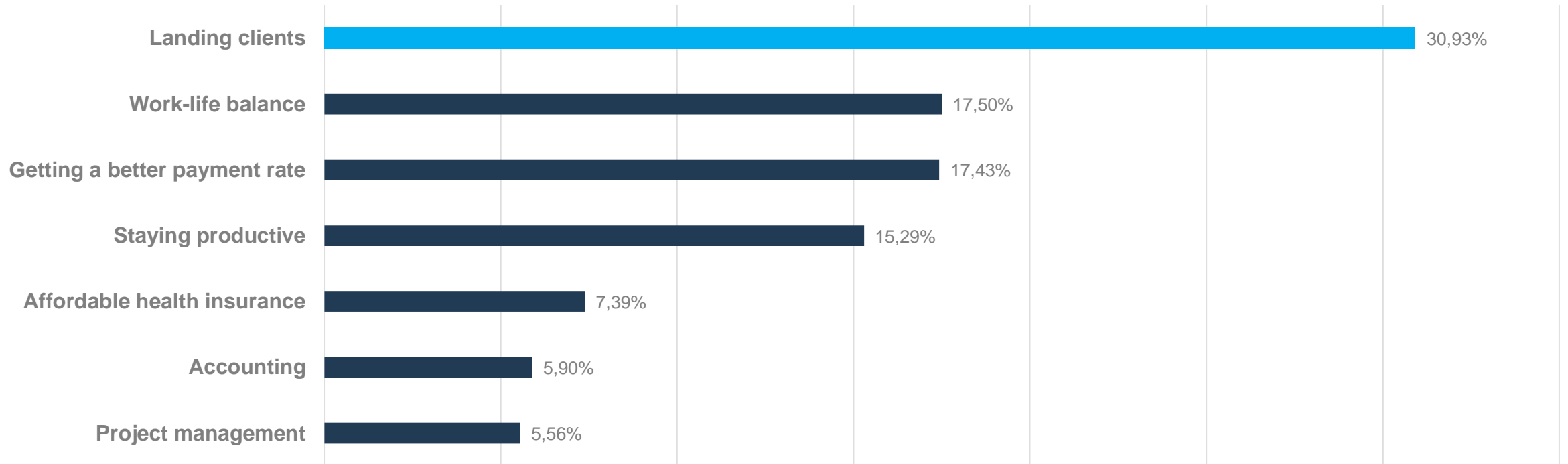
38.24% said they would describe themselves as lone fighters.

MAJOR CHALLENGES

What are the biggest challenges for freelancers?

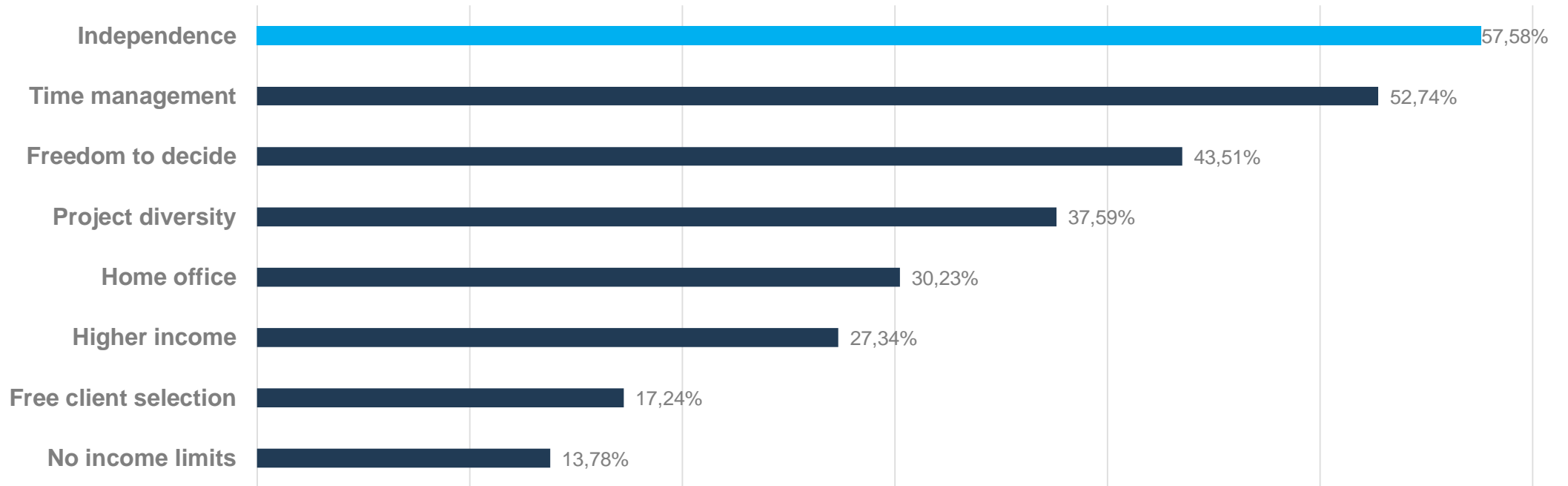


30.93% said that **getting new projects** is the biggest challenge.

Mastering **the work-life balance** is a challenge for **17.50%**, followed shortly by **getting better payments (17.43%)**. **Bookkeeping (5.90%)**, and **project management (5.56%)** are at the bottom of the biggest challenges faced by freelancers.

BENEFITS OF FREELANCING

In your opinion, what are the main benefits of freelancing?

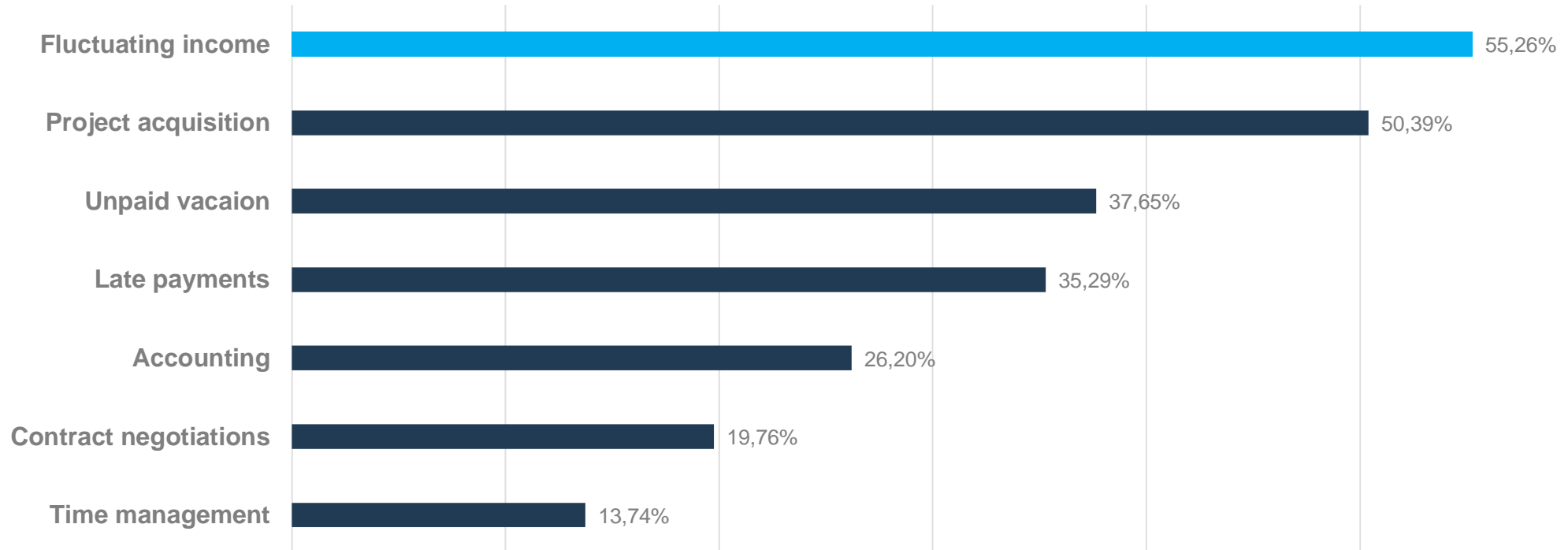


Independence (57.58%), freedom to decide about your working time (52.74%) and generally, what you do (43.51%) were the advantages reported **most often**.

According to the data, **earning more money is not so important** for freelancers (just **14%** cited that).

DISADVANTAGES OF FREELANCING

What are the worst disadvantages of freelancing?

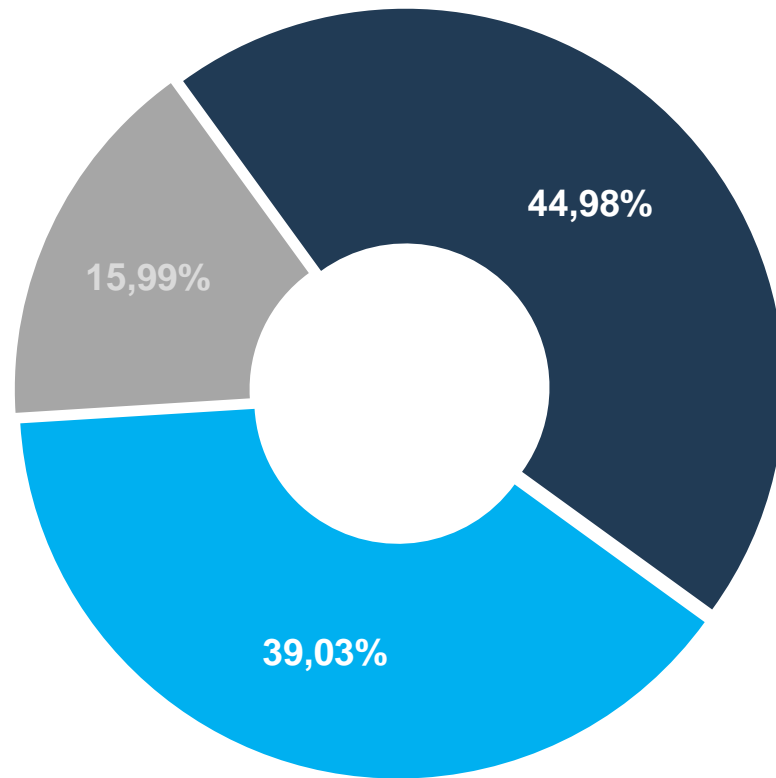


55.26% of freelancers cited **fluctuating income** as the biggest disadvantage.

Client acquisition was the second most cited disadvantage with **50.39%**. On the third place, **unpaid vacation** with **37.65%**, closely followed by **late payments (35.26%)**.

WILLINGNESS TO RELOCATE

Are you willing to relocate for a project?

- No, I just work with local clients or remotely
- Yes, but just in my country/continent

OF COURSE, NO MATTER WHERE!

The majority (44.98%) would move to another country to complete a project.

NO, JUST LOCALLY OR REMOTE

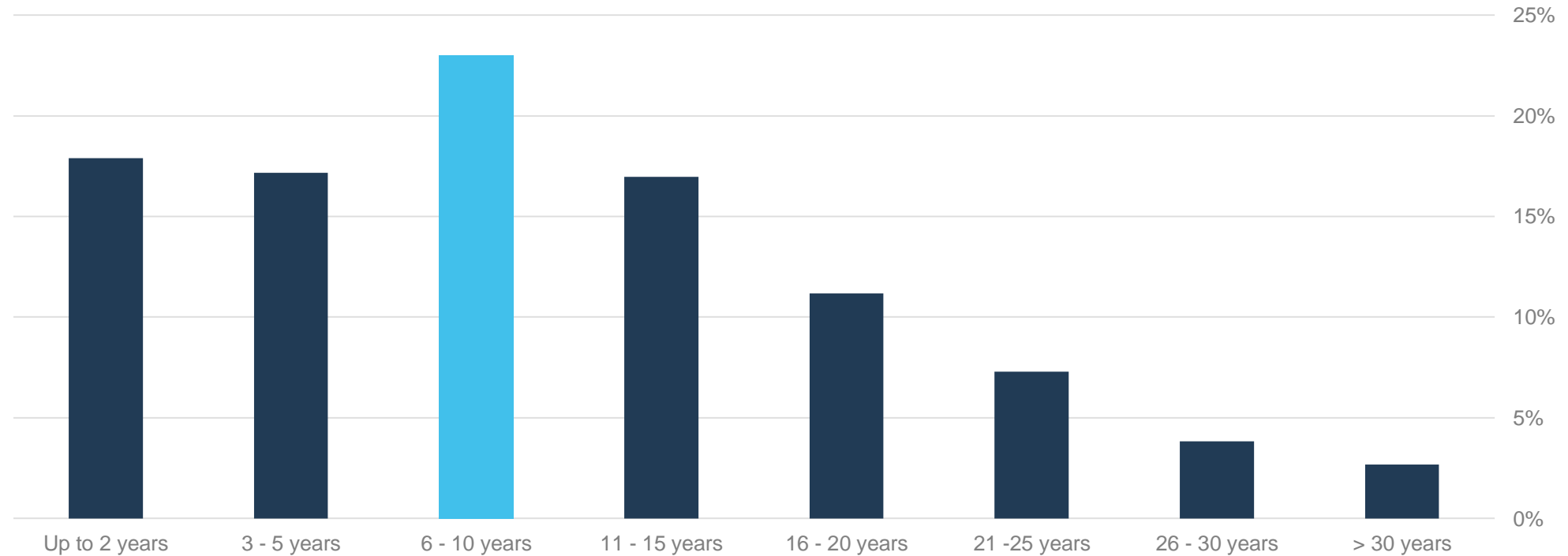
39.03% are not interested in travelling for work. They just work with local clients or remotely.

OPEN BUT WITH LIMITATIONS

8.55% would relocate for a project only in their country. While 7.43% would open their borders to the continent.

YEARS FREELANCING

How long have you been freelancing?

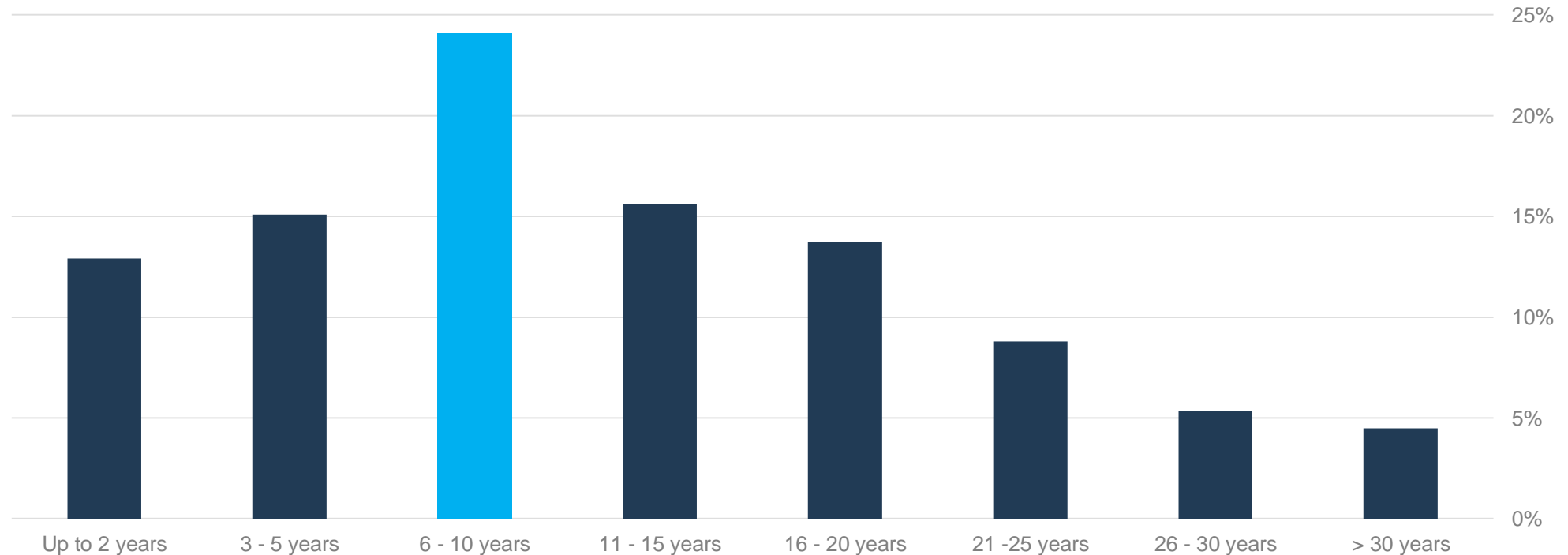


On average, interviewed **freelancers have been freelancing for 10.7 years**

More than a half (58.08%) of freelancers have been freelancing for **less than 10 years**. And just **13.78%** more than 20 years.

EXPERIENCE BEFORE FREELANCING

How many years of work experience did you have before taking the leap into freelancing?



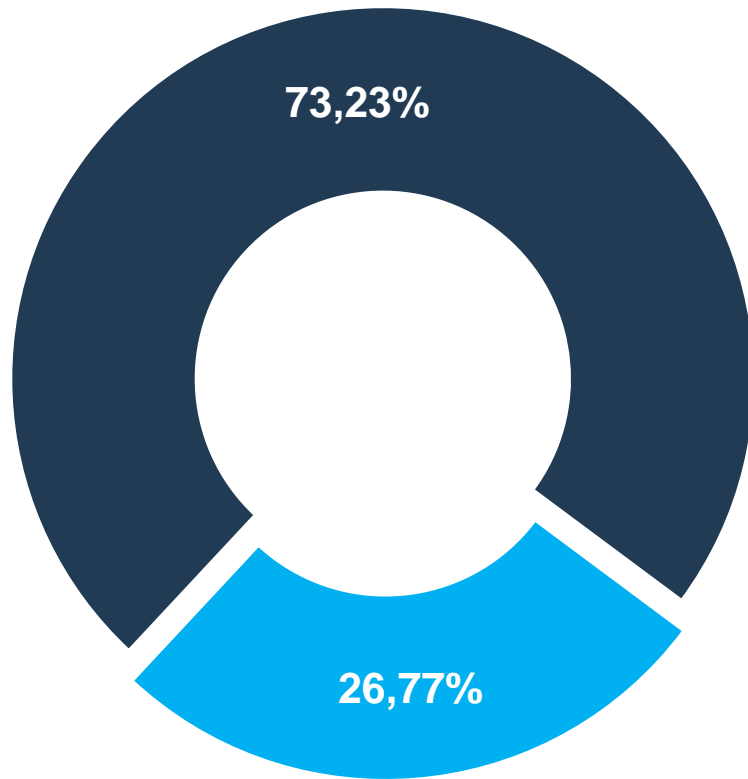
On average, freelancers had been working **12.61 years** before taking the leap.

The majority of freelancers (24.10%) confirmed they had between **6-10 years of professional experience**.

10% of freelancers decided to go freelancer with **over 25 years working experience** under their belt.

ACTUAL PROJECT SITUATION

IN A PROJECT RIGHT NOW

73.23% were in a project at the moment of completing the survey.

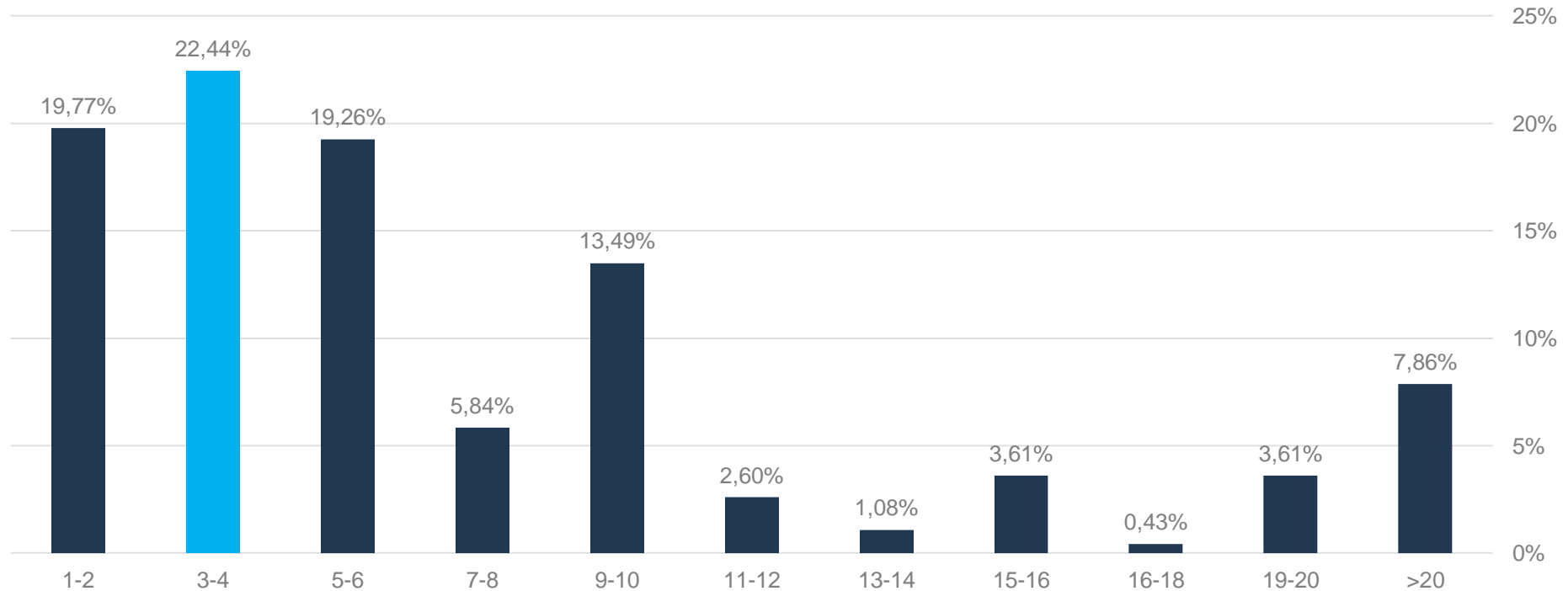
NOT IN A PROJECT

26.77% confirmed they were not in a project.

Mainly reasons: There were **no interesting opportunities** or they were in a **pause between projects**.

APPLICATIONS AND PROPOSALS

On average, how many different projects do you apply for before you land a successful contract?

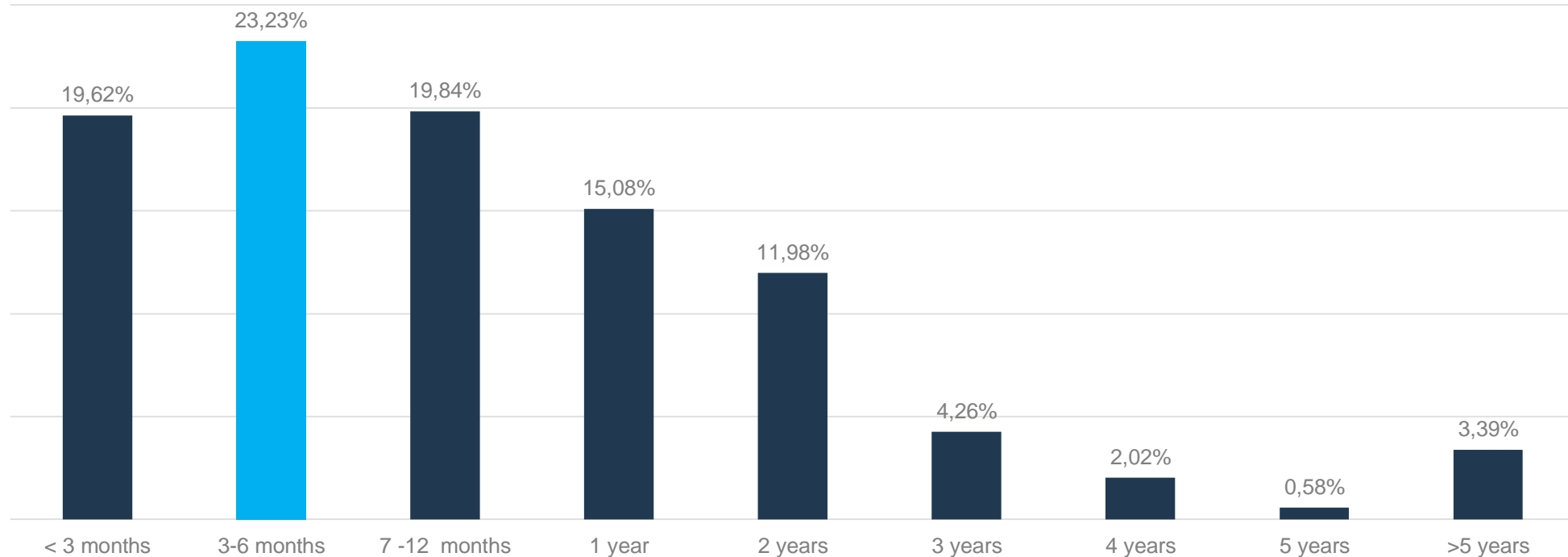


22.44% of all freelancers said they send **3 or 4 proposals** before getting a new project.

The majority of freelancers (**61.47%**) send **up to 6 applications** before landing a client. **Just 19%** of freelancers need to send **more than 10 proposals**.

PROJECT DURATION

How long do you normally spend on a project?

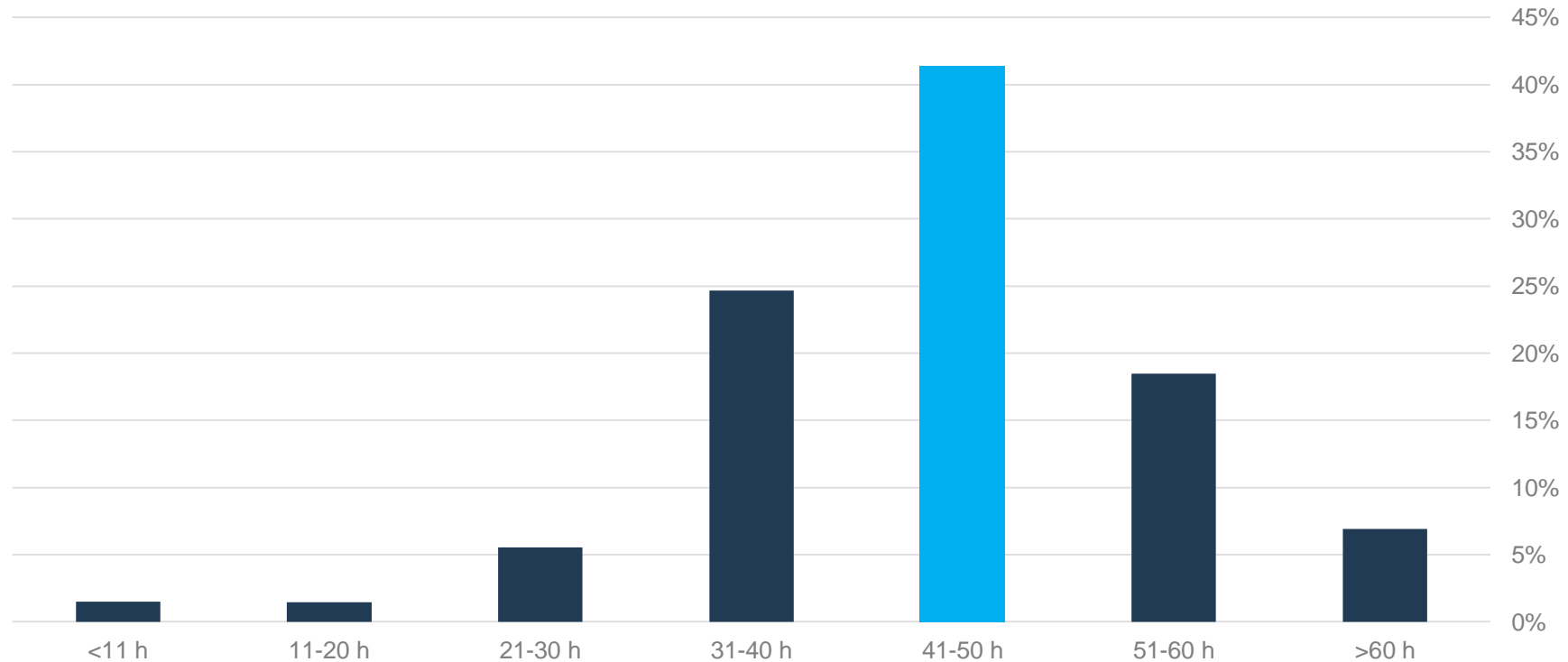


77.78% of freelancers typically spend up to a year on a project.

Only **10.25 %** of freelancers confirmed that they work on projects for **more than 3 years**.

WORKING HOURS PER WEEK

How many hours do you work per week?

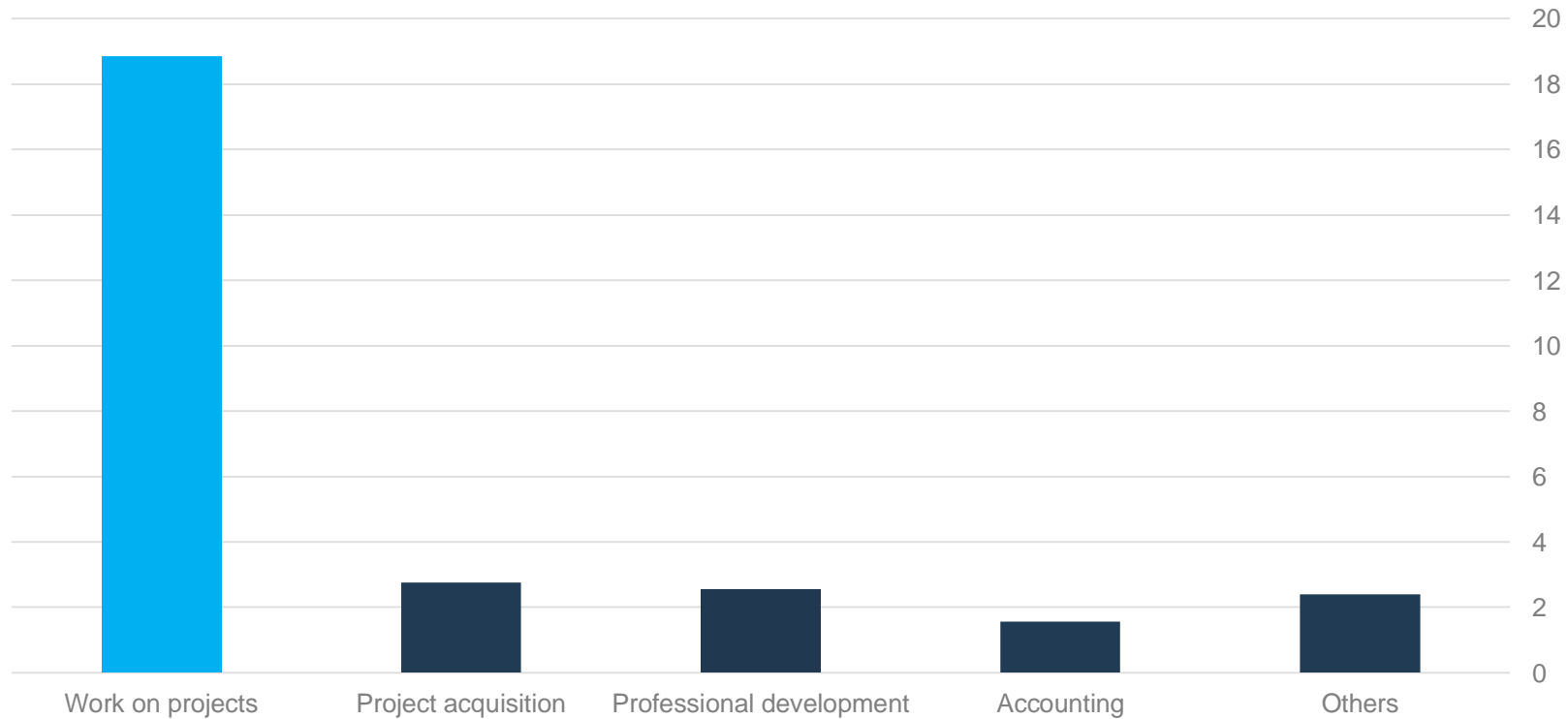


According to the survey, freelancers work an average of **46.66 h/week**.

The majority of freelancers (41.41%) work between 41 and 50 hours per week. **25.39%** confirmed that they work **over 50 hours**. Another **25%** work **31 - 40 hours** and just 9% work less than 30 hours weekly.

MONTHLY WORK DISTRIBUTION

How do you split up your monthly working time of 30 days?

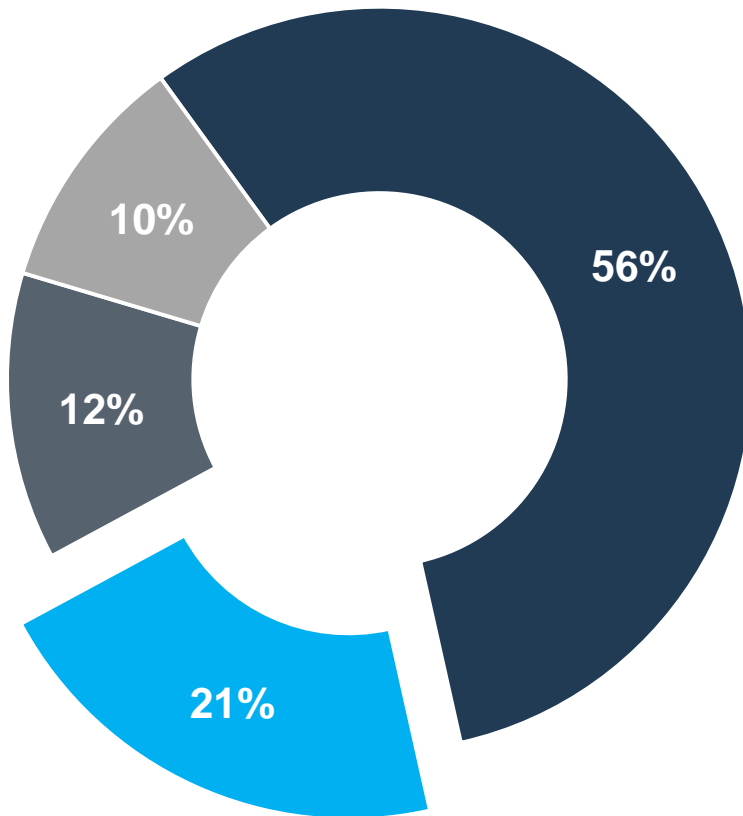


Freelancers spend on average **18.83 days** per month working on projects.

Around 2 days are invested in **project acquisition, professional development and accounting**, and the rest of the time they have to deal with other general issues.

FREELANCERS vs. EMPLOYEES

Do you earn more than your colleagues working on a full-time job?

NO

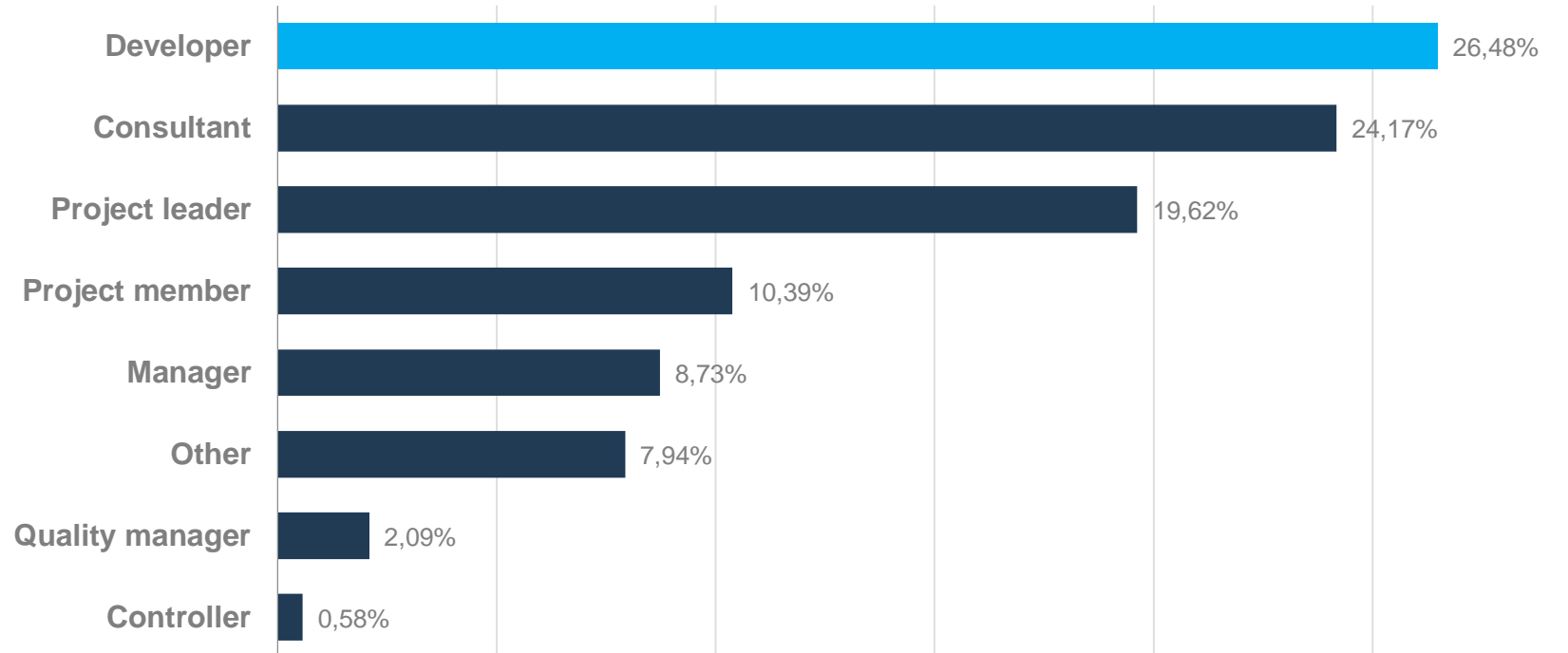
12% responded that they are earning less..

What was your position in the last (or current) project?

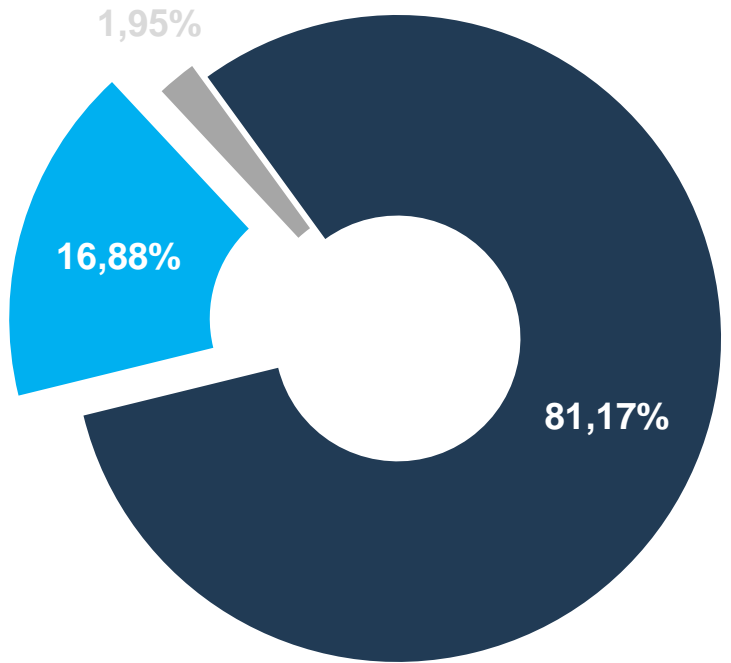


26.48% of all freelancers were working as **developers**.

After developers: **consultants (24.17%)** and **project leaders (19.62%)**. These **three roles** make the **70.27%** of all respondents.

FREELANCING IN THE FUTURE

Do you want to continue working as a freelancer?

The majority (81.17%) want to keep working on a freelance basis.

OPEN FOR CHANGE

16.88% would consider switching to full-time employment if they receive an **appropriate salary**.

Responses were provided by freelancers spanned around the world. Among the most participative countries: **Germany, Switzerland, India, USA, Spain, LATAM countries and Australia.**

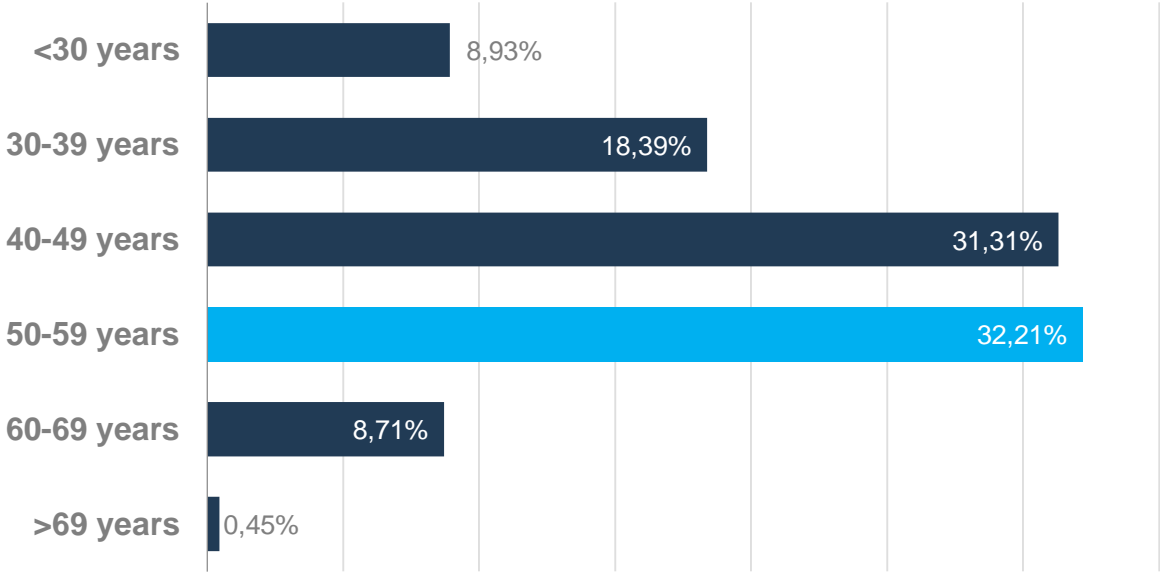
DEMOGRAPHICS

Who are the surveyed freelancers?

11.62% Around 10% of all participants were women.



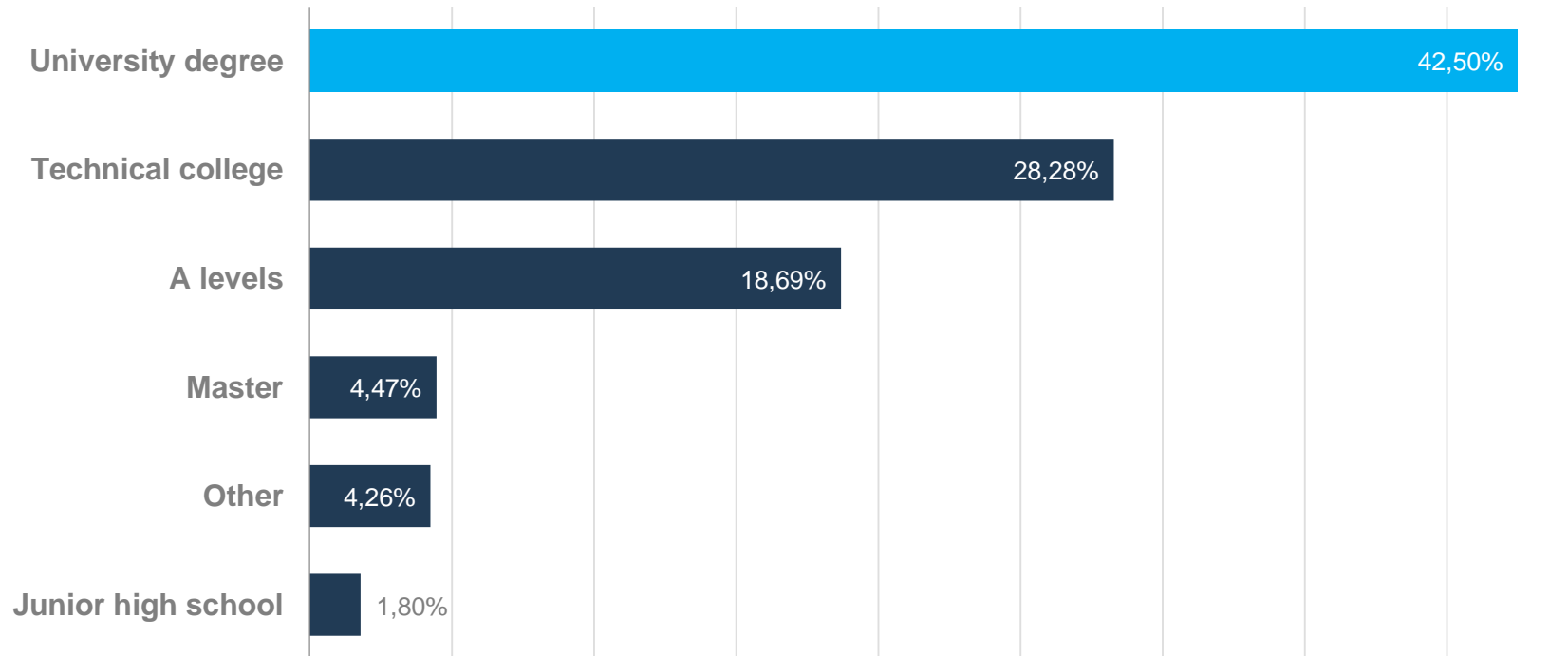
88.38% Slightly less than 9 out of 10 participants were men.



63.51% of all participants are 40 - 59 years old; 27.33% are younger than 39 years.

EDUCATIONAL LEVEL

What's your highest educational level?

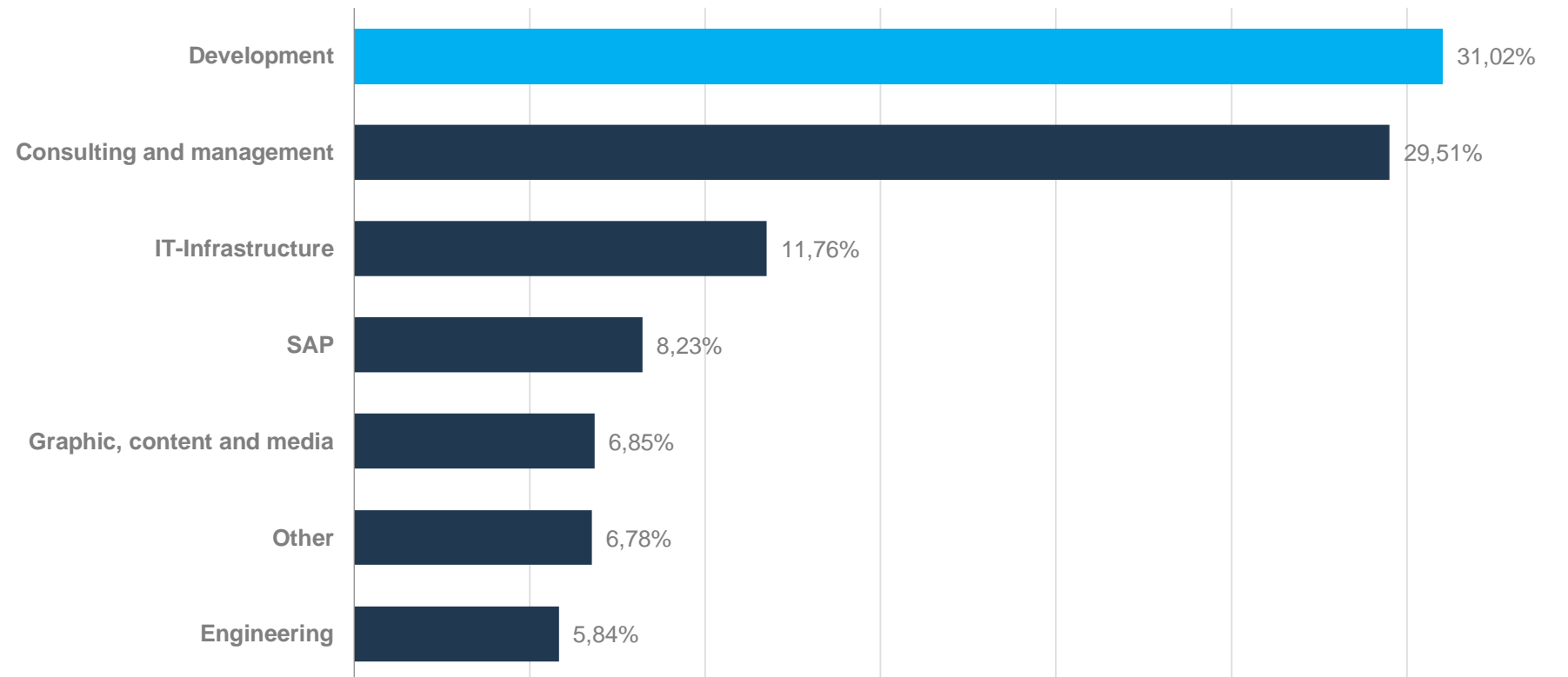


42.50% of freelancers completed a **university degree**.

28.28% studied in a **technical college** and **4.47%** continued studying and also hold a **master** certification. That makes **75.25 %** of all surveyed freelancers.

FIELD OF WORK

Which field would you put yourself into?

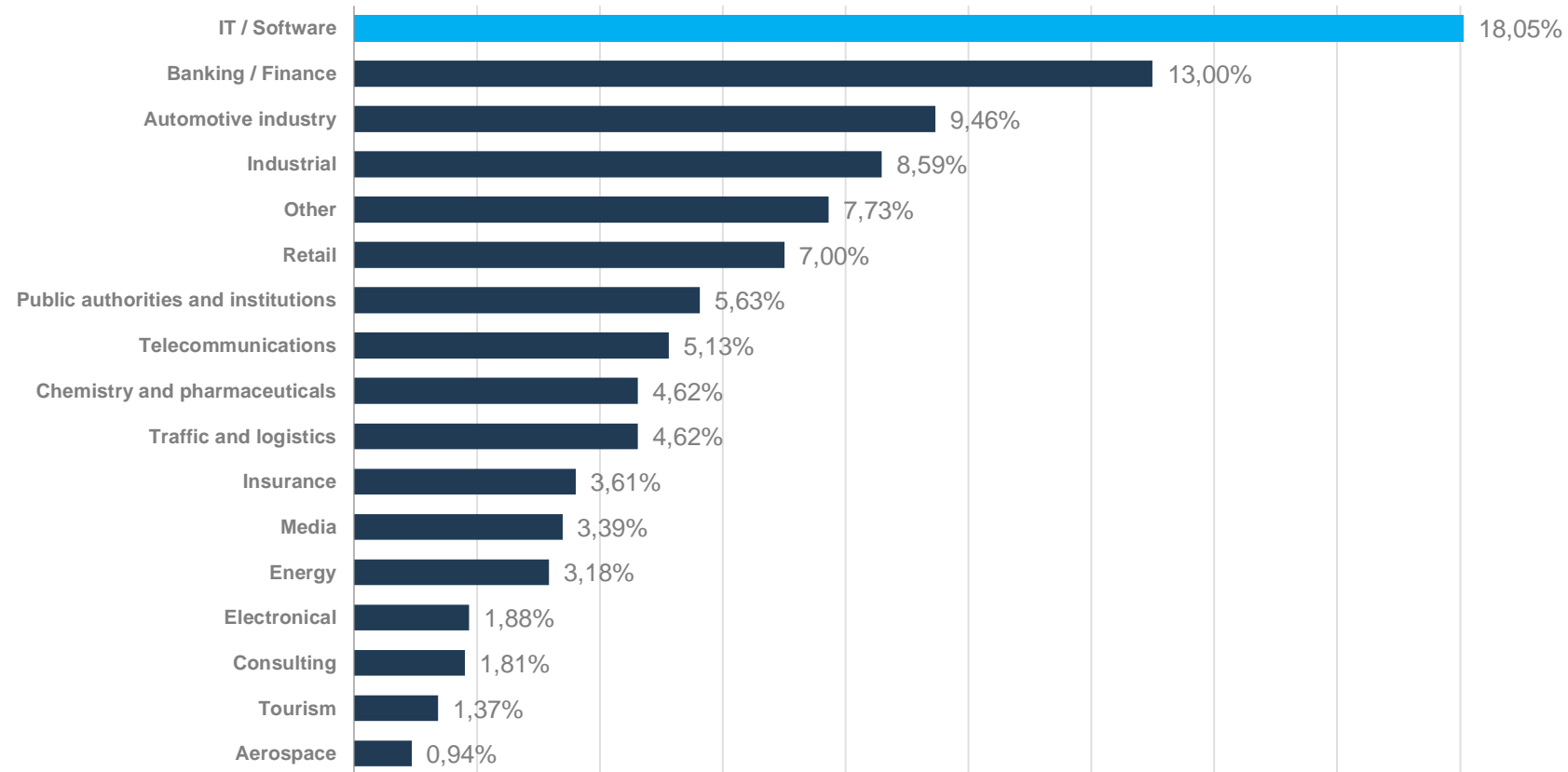


31.03% of all participants declared to be **developers**.

29.51% are working in the **consulting and management** field. **Consultants and developers** represent **60.53%** of all surveyed freelancers.

LAST PROJECT INDUSTRY

In which field was your last (or current) project?

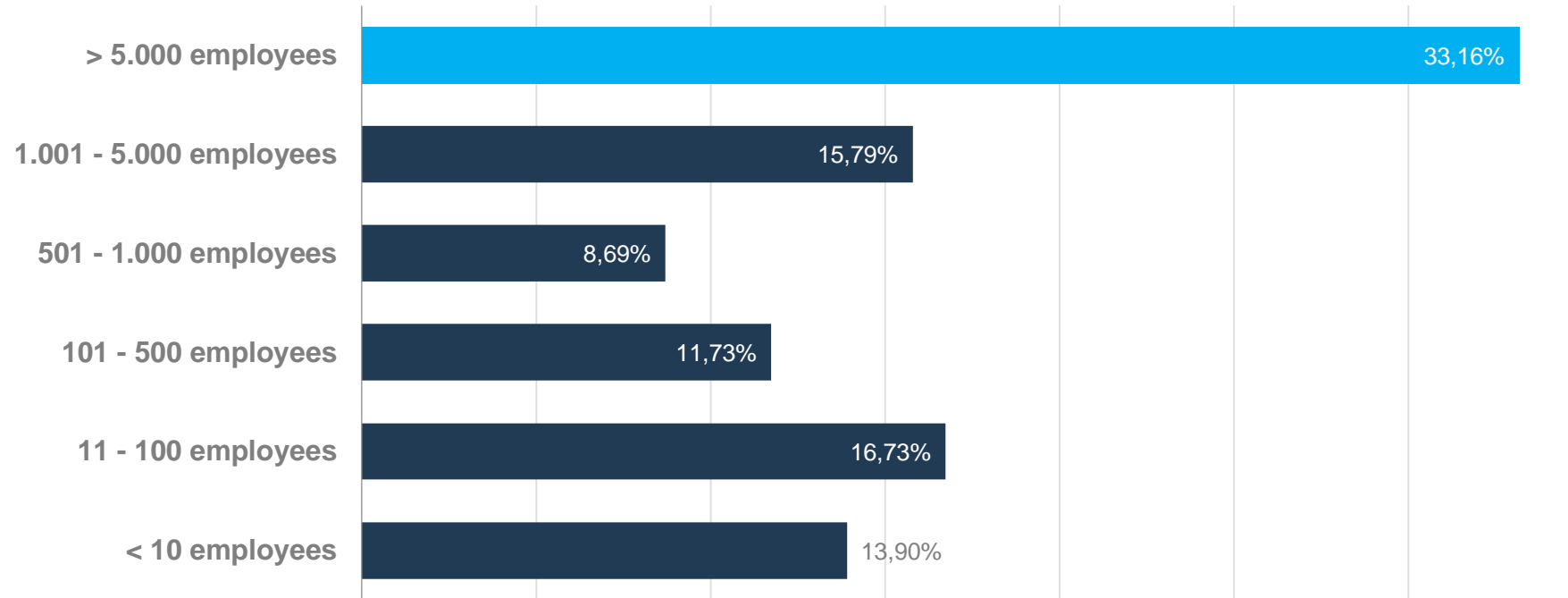


40.50% worked in the **IT / software, banking / finance and automotive industry.**

Followed by Industrial **engineering (8.59%), retail (7%) and public institutions (5.63%).**

CLIENTS AND COMPANIES' SIZE

What was the company size on your last (or current) project?



57.64% of all participants work in large companies with **over 500 employees**.

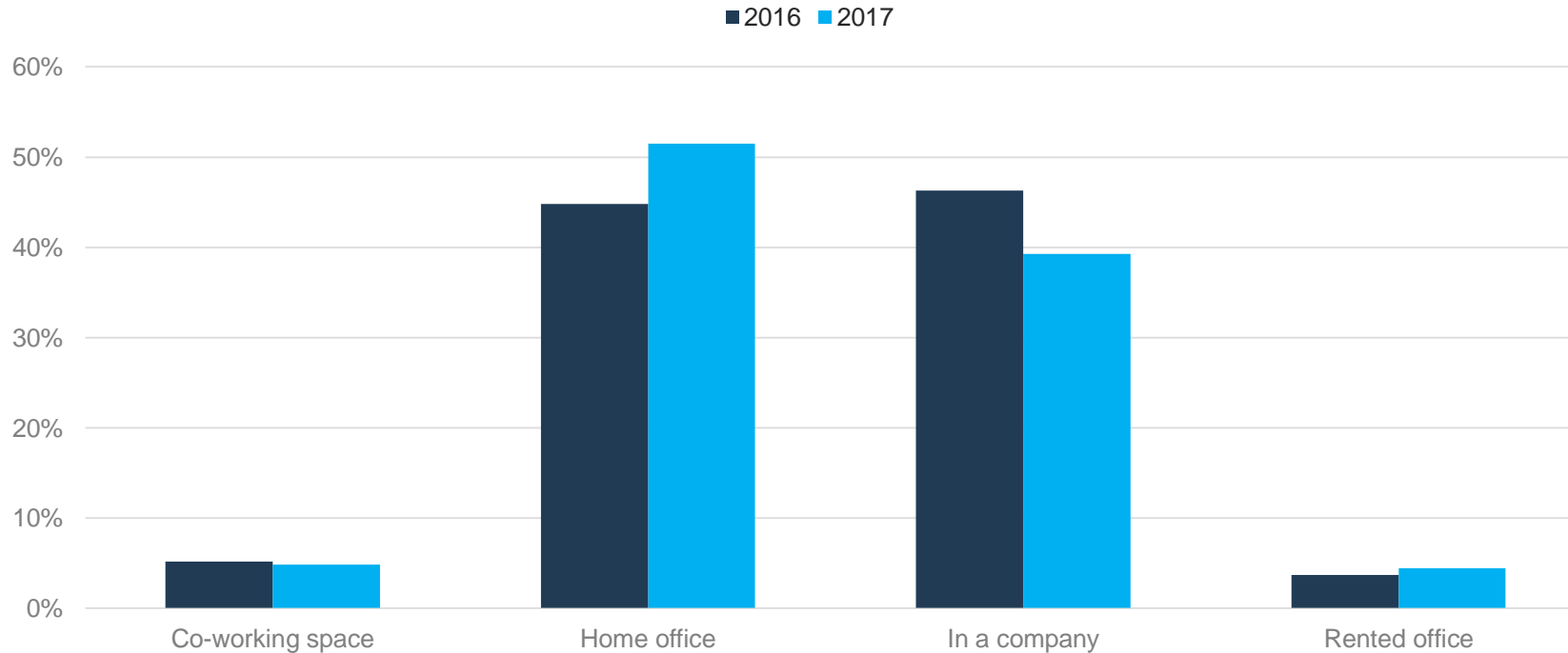
The majority of them (**33.16%**) are working in very large companies with **over 5.000 workers**. Only a **13.90%** of the surveyed freelancers said the last project was completed for a **small business with less than 10 employees**.



PLANS & DEVELOPMENT 2017

REMOTELY vs. ON-SITE?

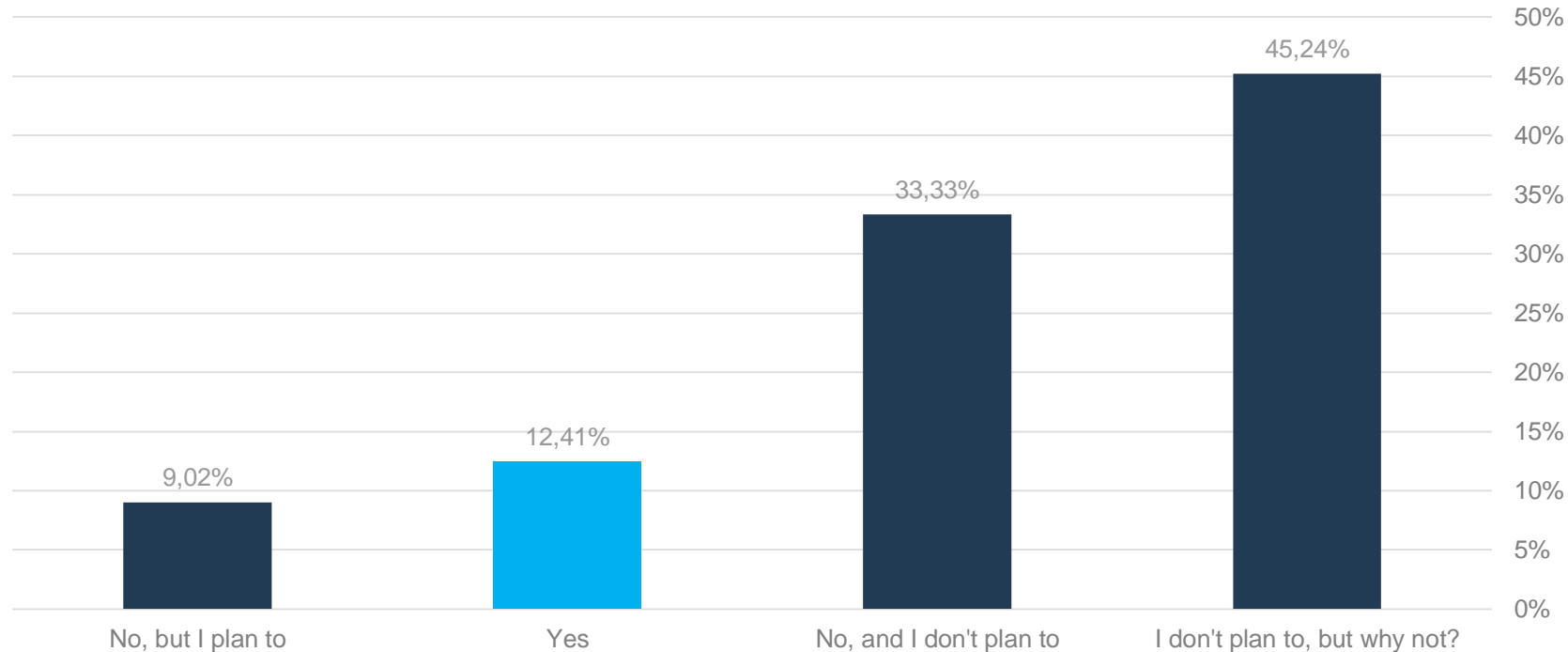
Where do freelancers work in 2017?



Compared with 2016, **more freelancers are working remotely. 51.48 % of freelancers** are now **working from home** (vs. **44.81% in 2016**); and **4.44%** do it from a rented office (**3.70% in 2016**).

COWORKING SPACES

Do you use coworking spaces?

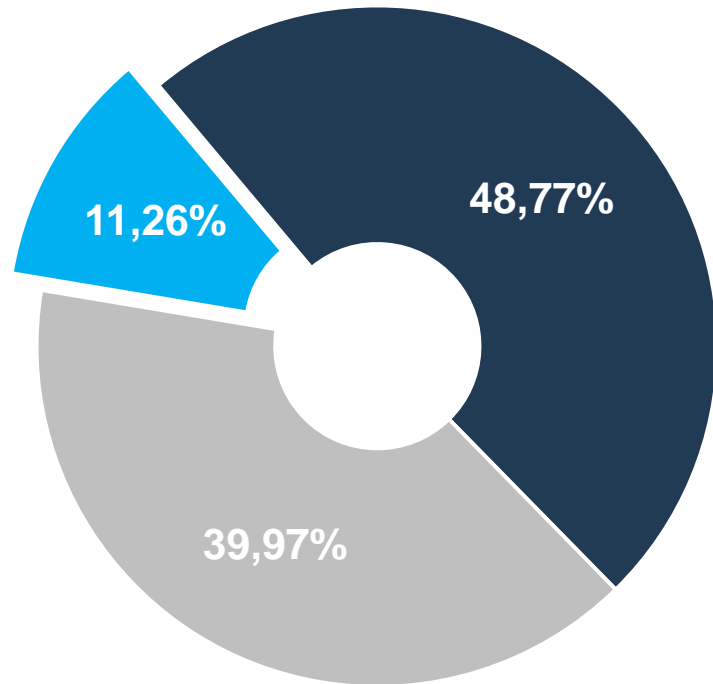


Showing the **freedom and flexibility** that involves freelancing, freelancers declared they are open for working from a coworking space. **45.24%** don't have it on their plan but are **open for it**. **33.33%** are **not using them** now and don't plan to do it either.

12.41% of freelancers are already using coworking spaces all over the world.

PROJECT VOLUME

Do you expect the volume of projects you receive to change in 2017?

SAME PROJECT WORKLOAD

48.77 % confirmed that they are expecting to end the year with a similar situation than in 2016.

MORE PROJECTS

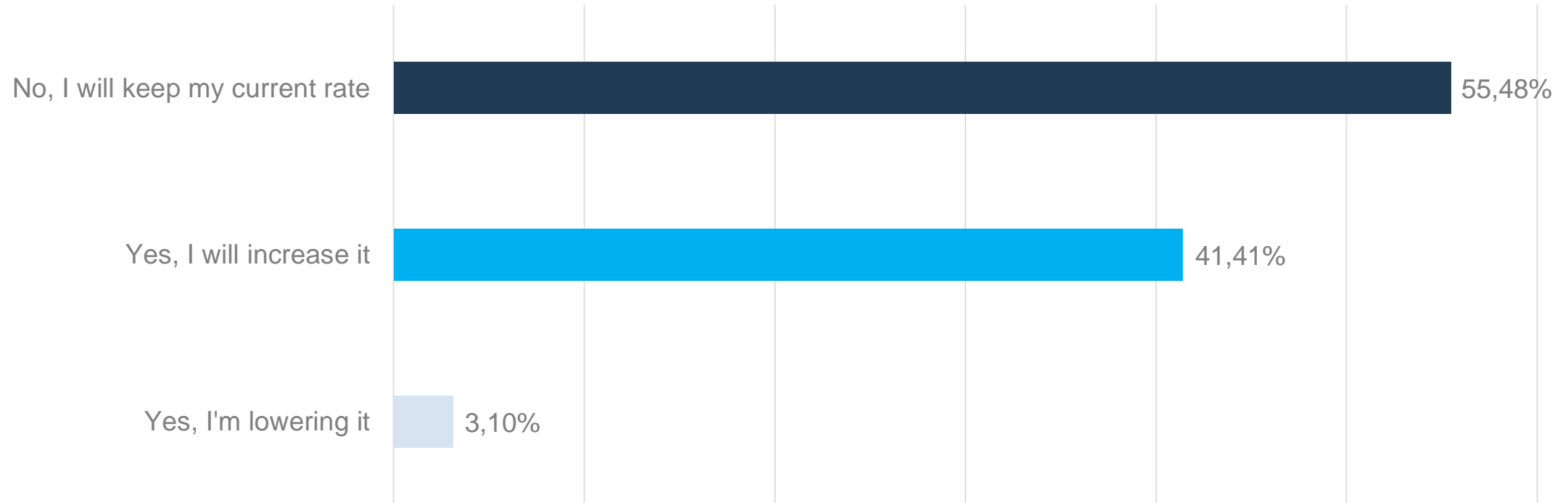
39.97 % are expecting a **better situation** in terms of projects.

Are you going to change your hourly rate in the following 12 months?

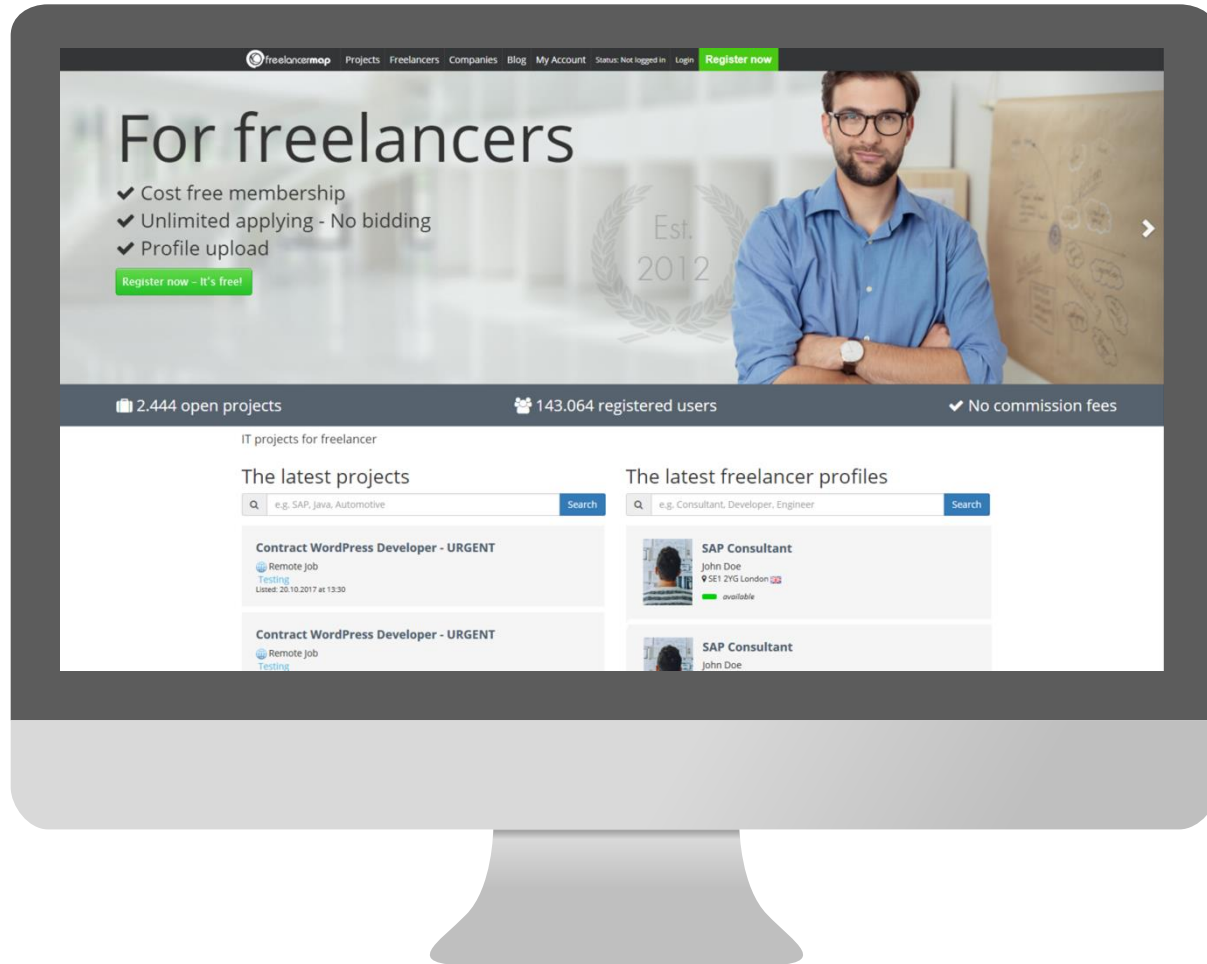


41.41% Is planning to **increase their hourly rate** in the next **12 months**.

The **majority of freelancers (55.48%)** are going to keep their current rate. Just a **3.10%** plan to **lower their rates**.
